

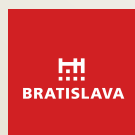
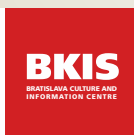

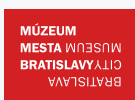

The Cultural Summer and Castle Festival is the biggest and longest festival in Slovakia. How do you perceive it from the point of view of the capital city?

This year, Bratislava celebrates its 25th anniversary of being the capital city of the independent Slovak Republic. It has come a long way over that time. From a grey town with gloomy buildings, it has become a modern and more cultural European metropolis. Bratislava lives culture particularly in the summer when the biggest city festival takes place. It focuses on a wide spectrum of artistic activities attracting the locals as well as foreign visitors.

We have seen you several times at various cultural programmes in Bratislava together with your small daughter. How do you perceive the Cultural Summer and Castle Festival in Bratislava from parent's point of view? Are there any programmes that are simply a must for your family, and you do not want to miss them?

The Cultural Summer Festival offers parents and their kids a lot of opportunity to take a rest and have a fun. I like to go to the ZOO with my kids. They can spend the time in the fresh air running around and doing different things. This year, we are looking forward to the Children's Coronation Procession, and we are already working on the costumes for the Procession. The Children's Coronation Procession is a new programme part of the Bratislava Coronation Days, which have become a tradition of the Cultural Summer and Castle Festival annually held in the city.

The events of the Cultural Summer Festival take place in the streets, squares and parks, in other words, outdoors. Do you think this is also one of the reasons why they are visited by thousands of visitors?

We open public spaces, revitalize the green areas that have been neglected for years. Our aim is to bring more and more people into the streets. Unfortunately, we still have to fight against vandalism in the city, whether it is the eternal problem of graffiti or the disorder in the city. Gradually, we manage, however, to change Bratislava to a better and nicer place. The Guardian, a British daily newspaper, has recently written about Bratislava, being full of praise for Bratislava. Bratislava's development in the last 25 years has won praise also from this newspaper.

The Cultural Summer and Castle Festival in Bratislava has been annually held for 43 years in a row, and for the last 15 years, the Bratislava Cultural and Information Centre has been its main organizer, dramaturge and producer. In this long period, we have managed in summer to put together thousands of art projects and dozens of organizers.

Every year we seek to bring something special to make the Festival exceptional. I believe that in summer people should spend as much time as possible outdoors, and should take use of public spaces to meet. Therefore, it is my pleasure to invite all the citizens and visitors of Bratislava to theatre performances, concerts, workshops and children's events taking place in the streets, parks and squares of Bratislava. We have been constantly looking for new, untraditional places. This year, we are preparing the first map of public spaces. Do you like the music of the 30s? It will sound from Michael's Tower, from the tower of the Old City Hall as well as from the balcony of Primate's Palace. Do you know that each of the Bratislava fountains has its own story? We will tell you their stories within the series titled Fountains Coming Alive. Has it been a hard workday for you? Make a stop at the Old Bridge (Starý most) where a DJ's zone will be prepared. No fan of photo-taking should miss our big instagram challenge #sombratislava – a photo contest with Bratislava as its topic.

This is only the first invitation to a selection of some interesting events from the total of 300 summer programmes to which you can already look forward. The Cultural Summer and Castle Festival will be exceptional also this year. We will be glad if you enjoy it together with us.
